## Caffeine and Body

A lot of people probably have heard about the effects of caffeine on the human body. Caffeine is often found in certain beverages, including coffee, tea, and soft drinks. Research has proven that these drinks with caffeine can provide some health advantages. However, some experts also share their negative opinions about what could happen when someone ( 18 ). This is because even though it has positive effects, it does not mean that people should take a lot of it. DM

Many studies have proven the positive sides of caffeine. It can help people feel more awake and have more energy. An experiment with athletes has shown that caffeine improves their physical performance. There is even research suggesting that the chances of developing certain illnesses may decrease. ( ~~<19>~~ ), harmful results have also been reported. This comes from having a lot of caffeine. For example, people may get headaches and have trouble relaxing or even sleeping.

In fact, experts think that it is easier to get too much caffeine than people think. According to one organization, people should take up to 400 milligrams of caffeine every day. However, it can be difficult to know how much caffeine each drink contains. So, some scientists say that if the body is experiencing any negative reactions, it could be a sign of too much caffeine in the body. This suggests that people should ( 20 ). ## Forest Schools

In today's schools, students are not given much time to ( 21 ) and often feel separate from it. What if students could have classes in a forest or at a beach instead? This is the idea behind forest schools. Although forest schools have become popular in other countries, the first one was started in Denmark. People there believe in *friluftsliv*, which means "free air life." This is a way of life to try to spend a lot of time outside in nature. Forest schools use this idea to help children learn.

Although forest schools look different from country to country, they all have things in common. All children are given opportunities to explore and move around freely. They can learn by getting their hands dirty, which allows them to develop many valuable life skills. They also learn how to ( 22 ), with their teachers always close by. For example, they learn to make fires. In this way, students can take risks while their teachers make sure they are not seriously injured.

Though the education style of forest schools is different from that of regular schools, it has many advantages for children. Because they can start activities by themselves, children become more confident even when alone. ( 23 ), children learn to solve problems on their own, as teachers only help them when they need it. And because they are learning in nature, children can understand their connection to the larger world and where they belong in it.

## An Important Indian Bird

The Indian vulture is a bird found mainly in India, with a small head with few feathers and wide black wings. This Indian vulture is now said to be in danger. In general, because of how it looks, the vulture does not give a good image to many people.

However, experts say they have the wrong idea about the bird. This is because it is important for nature and human life.

By the middle of the 1990s, the number of Indian vultures dropped from about fifty million to almost zero. When experts did some research, they found that this was caused by a drug for sick cows. In other words, they died because they ate the dead cows that had been treated with the drug. Since the drug had become no longer available in the early 2000s, the decrease has slowed down. Still, according to one report, the numbers of several species of Indian vultures have been decreasing every year.

The decrease in the number of these birds has caused serious damage to human health. Vultures usually help remove dead animals from the environment, such as wild dogs, that contain bacteria and diseases. So, a decrease in the number of Indian vultures means an increase in the number of dead animals in the environment. This finally leads to the spreading of diseases. In fact, studies have shown that in areas where many vultures once lived, the level of danger to human health increased after the decrease in vulture populations.

Professionals agree that it is necessary to understand how using chemicals, climate change, and other human activities can damage the lives of animals, especially species like the Indian vulture. So, various actions are being taken to improve the situation. For example, twenty protected Indian vultures were released in one area recently, and the research that followed showed that their numbers were increasing. The researchers hope that such efforts will be successful in increasing the number of vultures in the future.

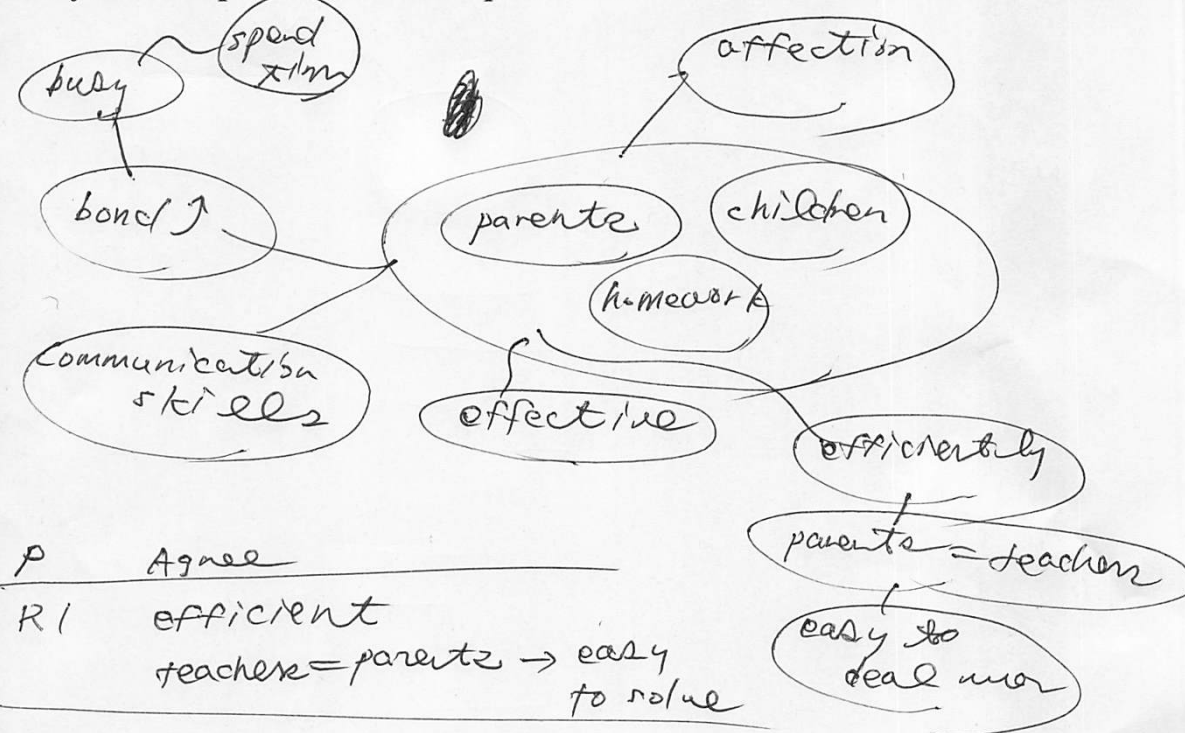
